



Puppets

A 'hands-on' experience for children in the classroom

Suitable for KS1. Supports the QCA Design and Technology unit 2B: Puppets

Children will:

- Handle puppets of all kinds, including hand, finger, string, pop-up, rod and shadow puppets.
- Explore how puppets are brought to life, and the strengths and weaknesses of different puppet types.
- Participate in a traditional Punch and Judy show, as a puppeteer or as part of a noisy audience!
- Find out what materials have been used, and what puppets were made of before plastic was invented.

- Compare puppet's facial expressions and experiment with using features for different effects.
- Take part in performances featuring stories from around the world, including Greece, Thailand, and India.
- Learn about shadow puppets and try them out.
- Make a detailed observational drawing of a puppet.
